

day of September One thousand nine hundred and twenty one Between
Jude Hanbury and Company Limited whose registered
office is situate at The Kent Brewery Wateringbury in the County of
Kent (hereinafter called the Vendors) of the one part and William
Bance of Holly Cottage Platt in the said County Paper Worker
George Bennett of Platt Mills Borough Green in the said
County Miller and Louis Curtis of Platt Common Borough Green
aforesaid Builder being the present Trustees of the Platt War &
Memorial Hall (hereinafter called the Trustees) of the other part
Whereas the Vendors are seized in fee simple in possession free
from incumbrances of the piece of land hereinafter described and have
agreed to give the same to the Trustees for the purposes of a site for
the Platt War Memorial Hall And whereas the value of
the said piece of land is estimated to be the sum of Seventy-eight
pounds Now this Indenture witnesseth that in
pursuance of the said Agreement and in consideration of the premises

the Vendors do hereby as Beneficial Owners convey unto the Trustees ~~All~~
~~that~~ piece of land situate at Platt in the Parish of Shrotham in the County
of Kent having an area of One rood or thereabouts and a frontage to the
road leading from Sevenoaks to Maidstone of Twenty-eight feet or
thereabouts and a depth of One hundred and forty feet or thereabouts
which said piece of land has formed part of premises known as
The Brickmakers Arms Public House and is more particularly
described in the plan annexed hereto and thereon coloured Pink
To hold the same unto and to the use of the Trustees in
fee simple as joint tenants In trust for the purposes of erecting
and maintaining a War Memorial Hall for use by the
inhabitants of Platt aforesaid as a Reading and Recreation Room
and also for Lectures Meetings and Entertainments and for such
other purposes as the Trustees shall in their discretion think
adviseable and for the provision of food and refreshment ~~Provided~~
~~always~~ that if either of them the Trustees or other the Trustee or
Trustees for the time being of these presents shall die or wish to be
released from the trust hereby created then and in such case his or
their place as Trustee shall be filled by the appointment of a new
Trustee or Trustees to be appointed at a public Meeting of the
inhabitants of Platt aforesaid called by the surviving or
continuing Trustees for that purpose by Public Notice at
least seven days prior to such Meeting **And** the Trustees
hereby covenant with the Vendors that they will forthwith erect
and for ever hereafter maintain a good and sufficient spile or
other fence not less than four feet high on the Eastern boundary
of the said land **And** the Vendors hereby acknowledge the
right of the Trustees to production and delivery of copies of an
Indenture of Conveyance dated the Tenth day of February One
thousand nine hundred and eleven and made between
John Gilbert of the one part and William Jude and Ernest
Osgood Hanbury of the other part and of an Indenture of
Conveyance dated the fifth day of December One thousand
nine hundred and nineteen and made between the said
Ernest Osgood Hanbury of the first part Percy Jude Sydney
Alfred Smith and Frederick Francis Smith of the second
part and the Vendors of the third part and hereby undertake
for the safe custody thereof **And it is declared** that
the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger
transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which
the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the

said premises ~~hereby~~ conveyed exceeds five hundred pounds

Seal to be hereunto affixed and the Trustees have hereunto set
