- 2. The Show is open to all gardeners residing (and on whose ground the exhibits are grown) within 5 miles of Platt Memorial Hall.
- 3. No person who employs a professional gardener may be allowed to compete in the cottagers' class, but will be classed as an open entry.
- 4. Open entries will be staged with the cottagers' exhibits but judged separately in each section, and awarded certificates and points. The winner of most points will receive an Open Challenge Cup.
- 5. Exhibits to be staged by exhibitors between 7.30 p.m. and 9 p.m. the day before the Show, and between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. on the day of the Show, accompanied by completed Entry Forms and Fees of 6d. per exhibit.
- 6. Judging will take place at 12.30 p.m., when committee members only will be allowed in the marquee.
- 7. Unless marked "Reserved", all produce will be sold by auction.
- 8. Any dispute as to the interpretation of these Rules shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 9. Awards of any kind not claimed within 7 days of the Show Day will be forfeited.

FRUIT CAKE RECIPE (Class 60)

WEETABIX CAKE-MAKING COMPETITION

1st Prize 15/- 2nd Prize 10/- 3rd Prize 5/Donated by: Weetabix Limited, Burton Latimer, Nr. Kettering, Northants

For the best LIGHT FRUIT CAKE made from Weetabix Perfect Self-Raising Flour use the following recipe:

4 oz. Margarine 4 oz. Caster Sugar 2 good size eggs 6 oz. Weetabix Perfect Self-Raising Flour Pinch of Salt 1-2 Tablespoons Milk and 4 oz. Dried Fruit (Whitworths Spin Washed Dried Fruit Mixture is recommended otherwise dry fruit well after washing).

Grease and flour a 6in. tin. Prepare the oven at a moderate heat (3250 Fahr. or Regulo 3). Cream the fat and sugar. Take a heaped tablespoon from the weighted flour and beat the first egg into the mixture very well before adding the next. Blend in the rest of the flour with sufficient milk to give a soft dropping consistency and finally stir in the fruit.

Place the mixture straight away into the tin and bake for about 75 minutes but reduce the oven temperature slightly after about an hour. Cooking time and temperature approximate, make any slight adjustment to suit your own cooker.

CONDITIONS

- 1. All the cakes must be made from Weetabix Perfect Self-Raising Flour and the empty bags from which the flour has been used must be handed in with the entry.
- 2. The recipe must be followed and ingredients used as stated.
- 3. Place your name and address in a sealed envelope and attach it to your cake.
